## **The Risk of the Incarnation**

### Psalm 22

The New Testament descriptions of the sufferings of Jesus use the words of this psalm in four ways:

#### 22:1-21 Suffering

Jesus prayed from the cross, My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? (22:1; Matt 27:46; Mark 15:34). He lost his sense of the Father's presence as he bore the guilt and filth of the sin of the world, but still he prayed, 'My God, my God.'

His enemies mocked, saying 'He trusts in god; let God deliver him now, if he wants to' (22:8; Matt 27:39-44).

The soldiers divided his clothes among themselves, and cast lots for his tunic (22:18; John 19:23-24).

His hands and feet were pierced (22:16; John 20:27). This verse is translated in different ways in different version, but it is clear that, whatever the psalmist experienced, his description of his sufferings in 22:14, 15, 17 could well be applied to a person being crucified.

#### 22:22-31 Beyond Suffering

The psalmist's prayer was answered. He was rescued. As for Jesus, suffering and death were followed by resurrection as God the Father raised him from the dead. The psalm ends with praise as the psalmist records that God answered him in his affliction (22:24).

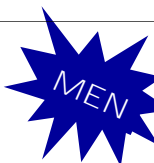
